Conrad Burns: The Facts

- \$ Voted to permanently repeal the death tax.**
(Bill HR 8)
- \$ Voted to eliminate the marriage penalty tax.**
(Bill HR 4810)
- \$ Voted for across-the-board spending cuts.**
(Bill S 1650)
- \$ Voted to make tax increases much harder to pass in Congress by requiring a super majority for raising taxes.**
(Bill S Con Res 86)
- \$ Voted to make the 2001 and 2003 federal income tax cuts permanent.**

- \$ Tester supports the death tax.**

- \$ Voted for Montana tax increases totaling nearly a half a billion dollars.**

- \$ As state senate president in 2005, Tester oversaw an increase of \$1 billion in state spending.**
